### **Advocate and Support Refugee Resettlement**

Returned Peace Corps Volunteers across the country continue to express their deep concern about the Trump administration's policies regarding the historically low levels of refugee admissions this year and its recent "zero tolerance" policy that separated more than 2,000 children from their immigrant parents at the U.S. border.

We are actively engaged in these issues and have encouraged RPCVs from 27 states to write letters and send 160 messages to their Senators in opposition to the nomination of Ronald Mortensen as assistant secretary of state for refugee and migration affairs. The nomination requires Senate approval, and the Senate Foreign Relations Committee is expected to take up the nomination soon. 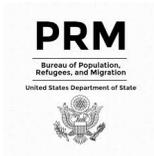
Mr. Mortensen's history centers around his extreme [anti-refugee, anti-immigrant views](#). He has made offensive statements about immigrants, elected officials, including Senators McCain, Rubio, and Menendez, and his own Mormon faith for the church's humanitarian position on migrants. [Certain Members of Congress](#) have already announced they will not be supporting his nomination given his anti-immigrant views.

## Advocate and Spread the Word!

Please consider writing a letter to the editor of your local newspaper in response to any stories about Mandy, or in response to stories on local refugee student graduates. It can be a short letter that references basic details of the article and encourages more positive stories and advocacy for refugee issues.

An advocacy letter could read as such:

*As a Returned Peace Corps Volunteer who strongly supports refugee resettlement, I encourage the Trump administration to reverse the government's dramatic reduction in refugee visas, which have reached the lowest levels in four decades. These reductions will result in thousands of people like XXXXXX (name of graduating student) missing out on the same opportunity to succeed.*



## Notable Refugee News Articles

The Wall Street Journal wrote an article titled [Americans Want an Immigration Deal](#). According to a recent [report](#) from the Pew Research Center, the share of Americans favoring such reductions has fallen since 2001 from 53% to 24%, while the share saying immigration should increase tripled from 10% to 32%. However, there is a continuing stalemate that benefits no one except hard-liners on both sides.

CNN posted an Article [The US is on track to admit the fewest number of refugees since the resettlement program began](#). About 20,000 refugees are expected to have arrived in the year that ends September 30, according to two refugee advocacy groups' analyses of data from the State Department's [Refugee Processing Center](#). About 16,000 refugees have entered the country so far this fiscal year, [the data show](#).
