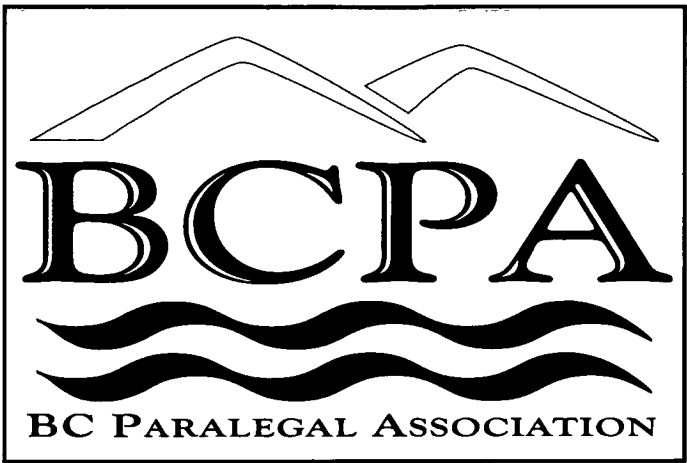

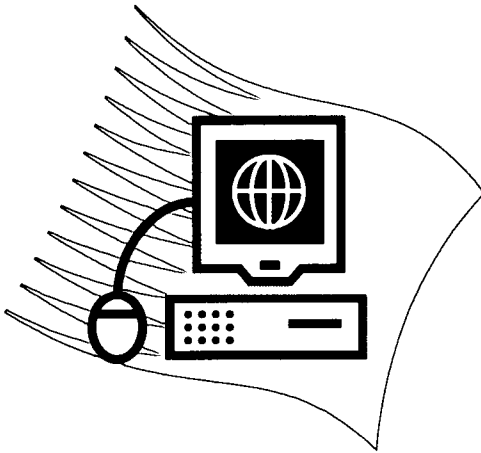

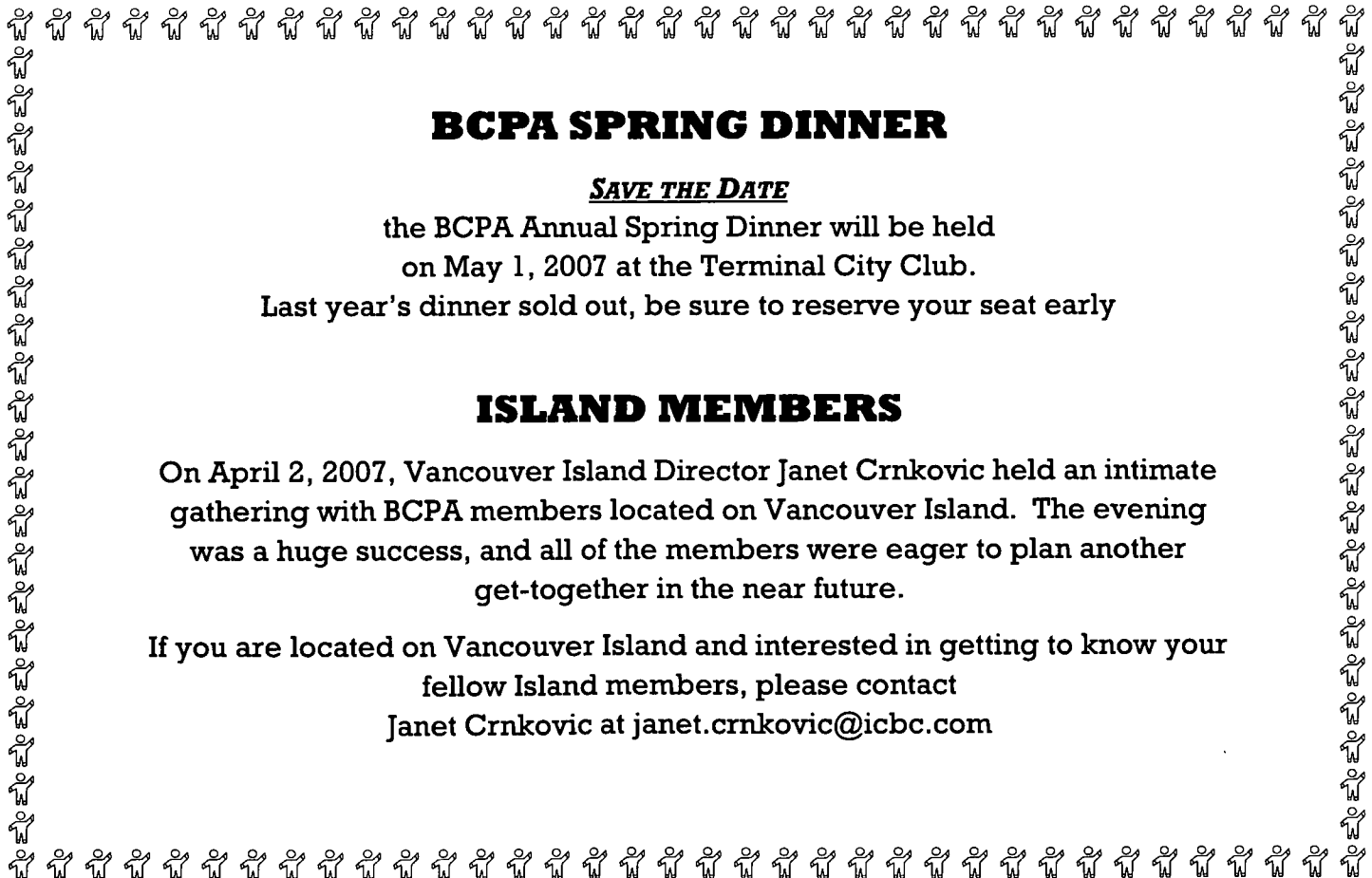
WEBSITE UPDATE

2006 SALARY SURVEY RESULTS

For the 2006 salary survey, the BCPA collected data from its members using the online survey site called survey monkey. The survey was designed to allow complete anonymity to the BCPA members, in addition to collecting more accurate information in a shorter period of time. We hope you found this format more effective and welcome your comments for improvement in 2007.

THE RESULTS:

On December 31, 2006, the BCPA records reported approximately 250 voting members. Of these members, there were 121 respondents to the 2006 salary survey. This represents an approximate response rate of 50% .

General Information - Of the 121 respondents, 96.7% (117 respondents) were employed full time as a paralegal. 88.4% of respondents (107) are employed full time, and in a law firm environment.
