JOHN B. CAMPBELL SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

This scholarship was established by the Washington Area Concierge Association (WACA) as a long-term commitment to the hospitality and tourism industry to support the development of skilled professionals.

Financial support is provided for enrollment in an accredited undergraduate academic program leading to a career in hospitality.

Scholarship offerings: The maximum amount of scholarship funding available is \$3,000 from an established endowment.

Academic Scholarships: Only one scholarship is awarded to any one student per academic year, as follows:

- Full-time student at a four-year institution, \$3,000
- Part-time student at a four-year institution, \$1,500
- Full or part-time student at a two-year institution, \$750

Full time is defined as enrollment of 12 or more hours for both the Fall and Spring semesters.

Eligibility: To be eligible, applicants must be enrolled or be planning to enroll in a U.S. undergraduate hospitality and tourism program.

Application Process: Completed applications and all enclosures are accepted through June 30th.

Application Review: Applications are evaluated according to the following categories:

- academic record/educational qualifications
- professional, community and extracurricular activities
- must have a minimum average of 3.0
- personal attributes, including career goals
- response to the required essay question
- neatness and completeness of application

Fund Distribution: Scholarships are issued in the name of WACA Scholarship Program according to the following procedure. Two equal installments are made in September and December. Checks are issued jointly to the recipient and the academic institution and must be used exclusively for the payment of tuition, fees and books. Any remaining funds must be returned by the institution. Any recipient who fails to enroll or cancels his/her enrollment must immediately notify WACA.
