ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

Executed by the undersigned for the purpose of forming a Wisconsin corporation under Chapter 181 of the Wisconsin statutes, WITHOUT STOCK AND NOT FOR PROFIT.

Article 1.

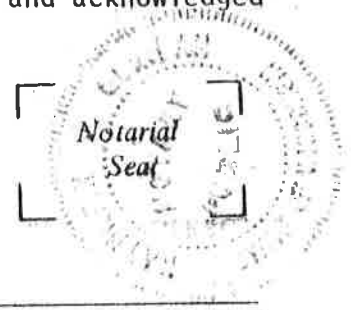

CONTENT OF THE FORM

- A. Article 1. The name must contain "Corporation", Incorporated", or "Limited" or the abbreviation of one of those words.
B. Article 2. Insert "perpetual" or insert any limitation desired, but not "indefinite".
C. Article 3. May show definite purposes or may use language to the effect that the corporation may engage in any lawful activities authorized by Chapter 181 of the Wisconsin Statutes.
D. Article 4. Give complete mailing address of the corporations principal office in Wisconsin, including street name and number, city and ZIP code, and the COUNTY within which the office is located.
E. Article 5 & 6. The corporation must have a registered agent in Wisconsin.
F. Article 9. Section 181.20(2) Wisconsin Statutes provides that the initial board of directors shall be named in the articles of incorporation.
G. Article 10. If the membership provisions are set forth in the articles of incorporation...
